(HA-91-6) HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. 00518 ADOPTED ON JULY 31, 1990

WHEREAS, the United States Housing Act of 1937 provides that there shall be local determination of the need for public housing to meet needs not being adequately met by private enterprise; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is authorized to provide financial assistance to public housing agencies for such housing; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 00445, adopted on July 5, 1988, the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego authorized the Executive Director to prepare one or more applications and/or proposals for development of up to 100 units of public housing and authorized the Chairman or Vice Chairman to execute an Annual Contributions Contract, a General Depository Agreement and other obligations as HUD may require with the prior approval of general counsel; and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 1988, HUD approved funding for 50 public housing dwelling units (30 with three bedrooms, 18 with four bedrooms, and 2 with five bedrooms); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 00463, adopted May 23, 1989, the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego authorized the Executive Director of the Housing Commission to submit to HUD a proposal for 47 units of public housing on the site identified as 12655 El Camino Real, in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, said proposal was submitted to HUD on August 3, 1989, and there are still 3 three-bedroom units remaining on HUD's allocation of 50 units which are yet unproposed; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego, that the Executive Director of the Housing Commission is hereby authorized to submit an amendment to Proposal Submission CA16--047 which proposed to remove 2 four-bedroom units from the previously proposed 12655 El Camino Real site, and combine them with the 3 three-bedroom units remaining on HUD's allocation, for a total of 5 units to be constructed on the site identified as 2893 Boston Avenue, in the City of San Diego.
