A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE BASIC CONCEPT DRAWINGS WITH RESPECT TO THE CON- STRUCTION OF CLEAN, LIGHT-INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES WITHIN THE MOUNT HOPE REDEVELOP- MENT PROJECT AREA BY CALIFORNIA CURL CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Mount Hope Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement such Redevelopment Plan the Agency has approved a Disposition and Development Agreement (the "Agreement") with California Curl Corporation (the "Developer") which provides for the development of clean, light-industrial facilities within the Project area; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement the Developer has submitted to the Agency the Basic Concept Drawings pertaining to the development of the clean, light-industrial facilities and has selected an architect, landscape architect and civil engineer for the development; and

WHEREAS, the Basic Concept Drawings have been reviewed and recommended for approval by the Southeast Economic Development Corporation, Inc., and the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that the Basic Concept Drawings submitted by the Developer are hereby approved, a copy of said drawings are on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. 1829.
