A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING RULES
GOVERNING PARTICIPATION BY PROPERTY OWNERS
AND PREFERENCE FOR BUSINESSES TO REENTER IN
THE CENTRAL IMPERIAL REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT,
AND AUTHORIZING TRANSMITTAL OF SAID RULES TO
THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has prepared a proposed redevelopment plan for the Central Imperial Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code section 33000 et seq.) provides for participation by owners and preference for operators of businesses to reenter within a redevelopment project area; and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law requires the Agency to adopt rules respecting the aforementioned participation and preferences with respect to the proposed Project a reasonable time before its approval of the proposed redevelopment plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Rules Governing Participation by Property Owners and Preference for Businesses to Reenter in the Central Imperial Redevelopment Project are hereby approved and adopted, a copy of the rules is on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. 1933.

2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to make available for public inspection such adopted Rules.

3. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to transmit a copy of the Rules, together with a copy of this resolution, to the Council of The City of

San Diego.
