A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CENTRE
CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO RE-ISSUE
REQUESTS FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE LINCOLN HOTEL.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency"), that the Centre City Development Corporation ("CCDC") is hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to re-issue Requests for Proposals ("RFPs") for the development of the Lincoln Hotel, located at 536 Fifth Avenue within the Gaslamp Quarter Redevelopment Project area. The RFP shall specifically mention that the Lincoln Hotel is in the Chinese-Asian Thematic Historic District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that CCDC is directed to locate another suitable property for Vista Hill Community Treatment Systems ("Vista Hill"), other than the Lincoln Hotel, under terms and conditions which are similar to those proposed in the agreement between the Agency and Vista Hill, for which execution was not authorized, on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. 1897.
