A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF  
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONSENTING TO A JOINT  
PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED REDEVELOPMENT  
PLAN FOR THE CITY HEIGHTS REDEVELOPMENT  
PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION AND  
MAILING OF NOTICE OF THE JOINT PUBLIC  
HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has prepared a proposed redevelopment plan for the City Heights Redevelopment Project (the "Project"), which proposed redevelopment plan conforms to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code section 33000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Agency has authorized and directed the Executive Director to submit the proposed redevelopment plan to the Fiscal Review Committee for the City Heights Redevelopment Project, to the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego, and to the Project Area Committee for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law authorizes a joint public hearing on the proposed redevelopment plan for the Project with the consent of the Agency and the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council"); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Agency hereby consents to a joint public hearing with the Council on the proposed redevelopment plan for the Project, and further, hereby requests that the Council consent to a joint public hearing on the proposed redevelopment plan and establish the date, time and place therefor.

2. That the Executive Director, or his designee, shall, in cooperation with the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, publish and

mail notice of public hearing on the proposed redevelopment plan, in the manner, and with other documents as required and established by law.
