A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF  
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RECOMMENDING THE CITY  
COUNCIL AUTHORIZE PAYMENT TO THE COUNTY OF  
SAN DIEGO FOR THE COUNTY EDUCATIONAL REVENUE  
AUGMENTATION FUND.

WHEREAS, State of California (the "State") legislation requires that each redevelopment agency in the State pay a proportionate share of two hundred five million dollars (\$205,000,000) into the County Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund; and

WHEREAS, in October 1992 the State Finance Director informed each redevelopment agency what their proportionate share would be; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego's share is two million seven hundred seven thousand five hundred seventy dollars and sixty-five cents (\$2,707,570.65); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that it hereby recommends to the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council authorize payment to the County Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund as follows:
