Properties, a partnership doing business in California; Greyhound Lines, Inc., a Delaware corporation doing business in California; and Transportation Leasing, a California corporation referred to collectively as the "Parties," and Geomatrix Consultants, Inc., for consulting services in connection with the hydrocarbon plume located within the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Sixth Amendment to Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. 1967.
