RESOLUTION NO. 2184
ADOPTED ON JANUARY 26, 1993

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE
ISSUANCE OF A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO SEVEN
ARTISTS TO SUBMIT PROPOSALS FOR A WORK OF ART
TO BE INCORPORATED INTO KING PROMENADE AND
AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$35,000 TO BE
PAID IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000 TO EACH ARTIST.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has determined that it should encourage development in the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, efforts have been made since 1989 to develop plans and improvements in the linear park; and

WHEREAS, on February 19, 1991, the Council of The City of San Diego named the linear park "King Promenade" in honor of Martin Luther King, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, the King Promenade Advisory Committee was formed in 1991 to develop concepts for the Redevelopment Agency's enhancement of King Promenade; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that seven artists be invited to submit proposals for a work of art to be incorporated into King Promenade as a tribute to Martin Luther King, Jr., the expenditure of \$35,000 is authorized to be paid in the amount of \$5,000 to each artist, and that the Centre City Development Corporation administer the project.
