RESOLUTION NO. 2190
ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 9, 1993

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CENTRE CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, ON BEHALF OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE BIDS, AND AWARD A CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION OF THE MEDIAN DIVIDER IN MARKET STREET BETWEEN UNION STREET AND THE MTDB RIGHT OF WAY IN THE MARINA SUB AREA OF THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has determined that it should encourage development in the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has determined that the construction of a median divider in Market Street between Union Street and the MTDB right of way will provide a safer and aesthetically pleasing street; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has determined to provide this public improvement in an area of several new or developing redevelopment projects in the Marina Sub Area; and

WHEREAS, it is now an appropriate time to advertise and bid the median divider in Market Street to provide vehicular traffic control and safety so that it might be constructed in a timely manner; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Centre City Development Corporation (the "Corporation"), on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for construction and installation of a median divider in Market Street between Union Street and the MTDB right of way in the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area.

2. That the Executive Director of the Redevelopment Agency, or his designee, is hereby authorized to award the contract to the lowest

qualified bidder, provided the bid is within the established budget.

3. That the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to administer said contract.

4. That the total amount of the contract shall not exceed One Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$182,325).
