RESOLUTION NO. 2189
ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 9, 1993

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING CENTRE CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, ON BEHALF OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE BIDS, AND AWARD A CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SIDEWALKS OF FIRST AND FRONT STREETS FROM THE CONVENTION CENTER TO CENTRE CITY IN THE MARINA SUB AREA OF THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has determined that it should encourage development in the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has determined that there are functional and safety needs to provide interim improvements to the sidewalks between the Convention Center and Centre City in the Marina Sub Area; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has determined to provide the public improvements for the betterment of pedestrian walking to and from the Convention Centre by providing lighting and street trees along the First and Front street sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, it is now an appropriate time to advertise and bid the First and Front street interim sidewalk improvements so that they might be constructed in a timely manner; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Centre City Development Corporation (the "Corporation"), on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for construction and installation of interim sidewalk improvements for First and Front street in the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area.

2. That the Executive Director of the Redevelopment Agency, or

his designee, is hereby authorized to award the contract to the lowest qualified bidder, provided the bid is within the established budget.

3. That the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to administer said contract.

4. That the total amount of the contract shall not exceed Three Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Nine Dollars (\$375,569).
