HOUSING AUTHORITY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO
RESOLUTION NO. 00655
ADOPTED ON JULY 29, 1993

WHEREAS, the United States Housing Act of 1937 (the "Act") provides that there shall be local determination of the need for low rent housing to meet needs not being adequately met by private enterprise; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Act, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to provide financial assistance to public housing agencies ("PHA's") for such housing; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (the "Housing Authority"), which is the PHA, recognizes a great need for adequate housing affordable to low income persons in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") has issued a Notice of Funding Availability ("NOFA"), inviting applications for Fiscal Year 1993 Public Housing development funds; and

WHEREAS, in order to apply for funds under the NOFA, the PHA must adopt a resolution of support, HUD Form 52471, which authorizes the City Manager to apply for the units and the Chair to execute the documents required in connection with receipt of funding; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager of the City of San Diego is hereby authorized to apply for Fiscal Year 1993 Public Housing development funds for two hundred (200) units and to execute all standard form documents pertaining to said application(s); and

2. That the Housing Authority hereby adopts a resolution of support (Attachment 1), which authorizes the City Manager to apply for the units and the Chair to execute the documents required by HUD in connection with the receipt of funding for the units.
