RESOLUTION NO. 2318
ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 30, 1993

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CENTRE CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, ON BEHALF OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE BIDS, AND PURCHASE STREET LIGHT ACCESSORIES INCLUDING BALLASTS, SHIELDS AND COBRAHEAD FIXTURES FOR CONVERSION OF EXISTING LOW PRESSURE SODIUM TO HIGH PRESSURE SODIUM STREET LIGHTS.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has determined that it should encourage development in the Horton Plaza Redevelopment Project and the Centre City Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has directed that such conversion of street lights from Low Pressure Sodium (LPS) to High Pressure Sodium (HPS); and

WHEREAS, the Agency has proceeded to implement the direction of City Council by authorizing the purchase of street light accessories including ballasts, shields and cobrahead fixtures for this conversion; and

WHEREAS, it is now an appropriate time to advertise and bid these street light accessories for conversion of LPS to HPS in a timely manner; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Centre City Development Corporation (the "Corporation"), on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for the purchase of street light accessories including ballasts, shields and cobrahead fixtures to change street lights in Centre City from LPS to HPS throughout the Centre City Redevelopment Project and the Horton Plaza Redevelopment Project.

2. That the Executive Director of the Redevelopment Agency, or his designee, is hereby authorized to award the contract to the lowest qualified bidder, provided the bid is within the established budget.

3. That the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to administer said contract.

4. That the total amount of the contract shall not exceed three hundred thirty-two thousand dollars (\$332,000).
