A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF  
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO IN SUPPORT OF  
CALIFORNIA SENATE BILL 284, AUTHORED BY  
SENATOR LUCY KILLEA.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") adopted the Centre City Redevelopment Project ("CCRP") on May 12, 1992, in order to preserve efforts completed in three original redevelopment projects downtown and improve blighting conditions found in contiguous areas; and

WHEREAS, Centre City Development Corporation ("CCDC") is carrying out this redevelopment plan on behalf of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1290 ("AB 1290") was adopted by the State of California and became effective January 1, 1994, revising Redevelopment Law and adding provisions which would restrict the implementation of the "CCRP"; and

WHEREAS, a technical amendment to the AB 1290 legislation would correct this situation and allow CCDC to continue development as proposed with the adoption of the CCRP; and

WHEREAS, State Senator Lucy Killea has authorized and introduced California Senate Bill 284 ("SB 284") to cause the necessary technical revision to occur; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that the Agency's support be communicated to the appropriate legislative members for the adoption of SB 284.
