ADOPTED ON AUGUST 2, 1994

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING CENTRE CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, ON BEHALF OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE BIDS, AND AWARD A CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION OF THE MEDIAN DIVIDER IN BROADWAY BETWEEN THIRD AVENUE AND PACIFIC HIGHWAY IN THE COLUMBIA SUB AREA OF THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND THE HORTON PLAZA REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has determined that it should encourage development in the Columbia Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project and the Horton Plaza Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency has determined that the reconstruction of a landscaped median divider in Broadway between Third Avenue and Pacific Highway will provide a safer and aesthetically pleasing street; and

WHEREAS, it is now an appropriate time to advertise and bid the median divider in Broadway to provide vehicular traffic control and safety as well as an aesthetically pleasing feature; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That Centre City Development Corporation (the "Corporation"), on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for construction and installation of a median divider in Broadway between Third Avenue and Pacific Highway in the Columbia Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project and in the Horton Plaza Redevelopment Project.

2. That the Executive Director of the Redevelopment Agency, or his designee, is hereby authorized to award the contract to the lowest

qualified bidder, provided the bid is within the established budget.

3. That the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to administer said contract.

4. That the total amount of the contract shall not exceed one million one hundred seventy-eight thousand seven hundred fifty-two dollars (\$1,178,752).
