RESOLUTION NO. 889

ADOPTED ON JANUARY 28, 1997

WHEREAS, on October 21, 1996, the Housing Trust Fund and the San Diego Housing Commission, respectively, considered and approved a request to expand the Housing Commission's Downpayment Assistance Grant Program by utilizing up to 20 percent of the allocated \$200,000 for homebuyers earning no more than 100 percent of area median income; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 1995, the Housing Authority approved the award of funds to the San Diego Housing Commission for its Housing Our Police ("HOP") Program; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 1996, the Housing Commission accepted a recommendation of the Housing Trust Fund to broaden the HOP Program to include any first-time low income household wishing to purchase in one of the Livable Neighborhoods, as described in Housing Commission Report No. HCR 96-176;

WHEREAS, on January 15, 1997, the Land Use and Housing Committee recommended that the area to be included in the HOP Program be expanded to include all of The City of San Diego's identified Livable Neighborhoods; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the San Diego Housing Commission may use up to twenty percent of the allocated \$200,000 of Downpayment Assistance Grand Funds for homebuyers earning no more than 100 percent of area median income.
2. That the San Diego Housing Commission broaden the HOP Program to include any

first-time, lower income household wishing to purchase a home in one of The City of San Diego's identified Livable Neighborhoods.
