RESOLUTION NO. 00795  
ADOPTED ON OCTOBER 3, 1995

WHEREAS, on August 28, 1995 the Housing Commission approved revising Housing Commission Policy PC209.000, Mandatory Disclosure of Business Interests, waiving the requirement which prohibits employees from participating in a business relationship with the Housing Commission for one full year, applying the waiver specifically to those employees who have been terminated from employment due to layoff; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Commission recommended Housing Authority approval of this waiver and establishment of a threshold of \$500 (cumulative to an individual) above which proposed contracts between the Housing Commission and employees requesting this exception would be presented to the Housing Commission for approval; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego, that the proposed modification and revisions, as specified in Report No. HCR95-138 Supplemental, are hereby approved, and the Executive Director is authorized and empowered to execute the revisions.
