RESOLUTION NO. 00844

ADOPTED ON MAY 28, 1996

WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission on May 13, 1996, recommended Housing Authority authorization for the Executive Director to submit applications for funding under HUD's Public and Indian Housing Drug Elimination Program, Federally Assisted Low Income Housing Drug Elimination, and YouthBuild Program Implementation Grants; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission applications for funding under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will provide Public Housing Drug Elimination Grant funds in the amount of \$375,000, Federally Assisted Low-Income Housing Drug Elimination Grant funds in the amount of \$125,000, and YouthBuild Grant funds in the amount of \$700,000 to provide education/job training and on-site work experience to economically disadvantaged young adults in Mid-City and Oak Park Communities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Director or her designee is

hereby authorized to submit said applications for funds, and if the applications are successful, authorize the Executive Director to execute documents necessary to implement the programs, including amending the Agency Budget to include any funds received, all as described in Housing Commission Report No. HCR 96-061.
