A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING PUBLIC
COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT
REPORT FOR THE PROPOSED SAN YSIDRO
REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") on January 9, 1995, by Resolution No. 2606, authorized the

distribution of the draft Environmental Impact Report ("EIR") for the proposed San Ysidro Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, on July 17, 1990, by Resolution No. 1875, the Agency had previously adopted the "Procedures for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act and the State CEQA Guidelines" which require that the Agency conduct a public hearing on a draft EIR for a proposed redevelopment project; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 1996, the Agency conducted a public hearing on the draft EIR for the Project pursuant to the above referenced procedures; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Agency accepts the comments made at the public hearing on the draft Environmental Impact Report for the proposed San Ysidro Redevelopment Project and approves incorporation of the comments in summary form into the final EIR.

2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby directed to prepare a written response to the comments, also to be included in the final EIR.
