REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF

RESOLUTION NO. 2636

ADOPTED ON APRIL 2, 1996

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") previously entered into a development agreement for the purpose of remodeling the former Von's Supermarket located at 4310 Landis Street into the Police Substation, said construction now completed; and

WHEREAS, in March of 1995, the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council") authorized the construction of additional parking, salli-port, wash down and fueling facilities for the Police Substation, and authorized the acquisition of property necessary to accommodate the expansion; and

WHEREAS, in order to complete the project, more funds than are currently allocated will be needed; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds for the completion of the project are available in the form of a loan from The City of San Diego to the Agency

in an amount up to \$350,000 from Section 108 Loan proceeds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized to accept a loan from The City of San Diego, Section 108 Loan Proceeds, Fund 98207, Account 9544, to the Redevelopment Agency, in an amount of up to \$350,000 for the remodel and expansion of the Mid-City Police Substation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Year 1996 Redevelopment Agency Budget is hereby amended to include an amount of up to \$350,000 for the remodel and expansion of the Mid-City Police Substation project.
