A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE
DEMOLITION OF THE STRUCTURES ON THE L.I.N.D
SITE AND AUTHORIZING THE CENTRE CITY
DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO BID THE DEMOLITION
CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Little Italy Redevelopment District of the Centre City Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan the Agency proposes to demolish certain structures to provide a development site; and

WHEREAS, the cost estimate for this demolition work and remediation of soil is three hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$330,000); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Centre City Development Corporation (the "Corporation"), on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to

advertise and receive bids for demolition of structures on the L.I.N.D. site for new redevelopment.

2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized to award the contract to the lowest qualified bidder, provided the bid is within the established budget.

3. That the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to administer the contract.

4. That the total amount of the contract shall not exceed three hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$330,000).
