A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE
SUBMITTAL OF THE PROPOSED FIRST AMENDMENT TO
THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE CENTRAL
IMPERIAL REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND RELATED
DOCUMENTS TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has prepared a proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan (the "Amended Redevelopment Plan") for the Central Imperial Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Amended Redevelopment Plan conforms to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code section 33000 et seq.; the "Law"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Law, the Agency shall submit the proposed Amended Redevelopment Plan along with certain related documents to the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego (the "Planning Commission") for its report and recommendation concerning the proposed Amended Redevelopment Plan and its conformity to the General Plan of The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to submit the proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project and related documents to the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego for its report and recommendation pursuant to Section 33347 of the Law.
2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby further authorized and directed to submit to Council of The City of San Diego a report with recommendations and comments, if any, of the Planning Commission on the proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment

Plan.

3. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized to take such steps as necessary and appropriate to implement the authorizations and directions established in this resolution.
