A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF  
UP TO \$325,000 TO FRATERNITY HOUSE,  
INC. FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A  
4-BEDROOM HOME IN VISTA

WHEREAS, Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) is a program sponsored by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) that provides resources and incentives for addressing the housing needs of persons with acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) and related diseases; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego, as the HOPWA grantee for all San Diego County HOPWA funds, delegated HOPWA administration to the San Diego Housing Commission on March 1, 1993, by Resolution No. R-281614 and on July 5, 1994, by Resolution No. R-284212; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission has approved a recommendation to the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego (Housing Authority) for a grant of up to \$325,000 using Housing Trust Fund funds and HOPWA funds to Fraternity House, Inc., under certain terms and conditions contained in HCR96-155; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority, that the grant of up to \$325,000 is hereby approved, subject to all previously

stated conditions, and as described in HCR96-155 and shall be documented as approved by the San Diego Housing Commission's General Counsel and Executive Director.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Director of the San Diego Housing Commission is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out and implement this resolution.
