RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE IMPLEMENTATION AGREEMENT TO THE DISPOSITION AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND LINCOLN PARK ASSOCIATES, LLC (THE "DEVELOPER").

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Central Imperial Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan, the Agency approved by Resolution No. 2538 on August 1, 1995, a Disposition and Development Agreement (the "DDA") with Lincoln Park Associates, LLC (the "Developer"), for the sale of real property in the Project area for the development and construction of sixty (60) single-family dwelling units (the "Site"), a copy of which is on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. D-02235;

WHEREAS, on April 16, 1996, the Agency approved by Resolution No. 2645, a First Amendment to DDA, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No.

D-02597; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has negotiated a proposed First Implementation Agreement to DDA, as amended by the First Amendment to DDA, for the purpose of reestablishing the terms of the original DDA, to revise the Schedule of Performance, and to make certain other changes deemed appropriate by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the Developer has submitted to the Agency copies of the proposed First Implementation Agreement in a form desired by the Developer and the Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Southeastern Economic Development Corporation, Inc., has reviewed and discussed the proposed First Implementation Agreement and has recommended that the Agency enter into the First Implementation Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has duly considered all terms and conditions of the proposed First Implementation Agreement and believes that the conditions contained in the proposed First Implementation Agreement are in the best interest of the City and the health, safety, morals and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable State and local law and requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the proposed First Implementation Agreement and the terms and conditions thereof are hereby approved.
- 2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute for and on behalf of the Agency the First Implementation Agreement, a copy of the First Implementation Agreement, when executed by the Agency, shall be placed on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. D-02766.
- 3. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to sign all documents necessary and appropriate to carry out and implement the First Implementation Agreement and to administer the Agency's obligations, responsibilities and duties to be performed under the First Implementation Agreement.
