WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) issued a Notice of Funding Availability on July 29, 1997 announcing the availability of over \$6,000,000 in program funds and technical assistance in a consolidated competitive grant initiative titled "Community Partnerships for Resident Uplift and Economic Development"; and

WHEREAS, to meet HUD deadlines, the application was submitted without prior Housing Authority approval, as authorized by Municipal Code section 98.0301(d)(8); and

WHEREAS, the Housing Commission on November 3, 1997 recommended that the Housing Authority ratify the application submitted to HUD/HHS and to execute all necessary documents to receive such funding; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Commission was notified on September 29, 1997 by HUD that it had been awarded \$300,000 to implement and conduct the Community Partnerships for Resident Uplift and Economic Development program in partnership with the City Heights Community Development Corporation for a three-year period; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego, that the Executive Director or her designee is hereby authorized to accept from HUD a three-year grant award totaling \$300,000 to conduct an economic development program.
