RESOLUTION NO. 959

ADOPTED ON JUNE 30, 1998

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing Urban Development (HUD) announced the availability of \$288,498,934 for FY98 for a national competition of funds to develop a comprehensive strategy with programs to reduce or eliminate drug related crime in and around public housing sites; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Housing Authority authorize the application to HUD for \$361,140 to continue a prevention and intervention strategy at public housing sites including El Camino Real, Pulitzer, Market Street, Santa Margarita, Alaquinas, Calle Primera, Sycamore, Hollister/Grove and surrounding areas as well as scattered sites in the City Heights area; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Commission on June 1, 1998, recommended Housing Authority authorization for the Executive Director to submit this application; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego, that the Executive Director or her designee is authorized to submit this application to HUD and to execute all necessary documents to receive such funding.
