RESOLUTION NO. 00922 ADOPTED ON AUGUST 12, 1997

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has allocated funds for 423 Section 8 Vouchers/Certificates, to be administered by the San Diego Housing Commission in order to assist residents at the President John Adams Manor and Seaward Arms Apartments development sites who are "at risk" of being displaced due to owner prepayment of mortgages and assisted units converted to market rents; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission Board of Commissioners on July 28, 1997 recommended acceptance of this one-year allocation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that a budget revision increasing the Housing Commission's Section 8 FY98 program budget by approximately \$1,837,676 is hereby authorized to allow for the cost of two additional Housing Assistant II positions (\$66,988), office equipment (\$2,410), and rent to owners (\$1,768,278) for administration of these additional 423 units, and further that the Executive Director is authorized to execute all documents necessary to receive the subject funding.
