RESOLUTION NO. 2867

ADOPTED ON JULY 21, 1998

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF A CORRECTIVE ACTION ORDER PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 33459 ET SEQ. TO GREYHOUND LINES, INC., A DELAWARE CORPORATION SUCCESSOR BY MERGER TO GLI REALTY COMPANY, A DELAWARE CORPORATION; AND TRANSPORTATION LEASING COMPANY FOR THE PROPERTY AT 539 FIRST AVENUE, SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 33459 et seq., the Agency has the authority to issue Corrective Action Orders to property owners and other responsible parties for contaminated property within adopted redevelopment project areas; and

WHEREAS, the property located at 539 First Avenue, San Diego, has been determined contaminated, and the contamination serves as a detriment to the redevelopment of this property and

other property located in the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, in order to effectuate the timely clean-up of the property at 539 First Avenue, San Diego, it is necessary to issue a Corrective Action Order to Greyhound Lines, Inc., a Delaware Corporation Successor by Merger to GLI Realty Company, a Delaware Corporation, and Transportation Leasing Company; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized to issue a Corrective Action Order to Greyhound Lines, Inc., a Delaware Corporation Successor by Merger to GLI Realty Company, a Delaware Corporation, and Transportation Leasing Company for the property located at 539 First Avenue, San Diego, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 33459 et seq.
