RESOLUTION NO. 992

ADOPTED ON MARCH 23, 1999

WHEREAS, on September 9, 1998, the California Employment Development Department announced an award of \$1,439,057 to the San Diego Housing Commission and six collaborative partners for welfare-to-work programs through the Governor's 15% Special Project Funds; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego/Imperial Counties Labor Council [Labor Council] is one of the collaborative partners funded by this grant to guide hard to employ residents of assisted housing in the transition from welfare to work; and

WHEREAS, as a collaborative partner, Labor Council will provide services to implement the program through a contract with the Housing Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Labor Council, for the \$235,500 specified in the contract will provide, among other things, pre-apprenticeship and apprenticeship training and bring employer commitments to hire successful graduates in the hospitality industry, construction trades, and other trades as appropriate to the individual; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego, that the contract between the San Diego/Imperial Counties Labor Council and the San Diego Housing Commission, the form of which is attached to Housing Commission Report No. HCR99-029, is approved and the Chief Executive Officer is authorized to execute the contract.
