REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. R-03414 ADOPTED ON DECEMBER 03, 2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING THE ANNUAL PROGRAM BUDGET PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001-2002 AND AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE COLUMBIA SUB-AREA BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement redevelopment plans for the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. [CCDC], has been

authorized to administer the redevelopment projects in the Centre City Redevelopment Project

Area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego:

That the Execute Director, or designee, is authorized to amend the Fiscal Year
2001-2002 Budget by increasing the Columbia Sub-Area Budget by \$2,500,000.

2. That approval of this amendment constitutes authority for the expenditure of funds by CCDC in Fiscal Year 2001-2002, provided that funds are available from disposition proceeds, developer advances, that tax increment generated by the Project are, and from funds allocated by the Council of the City of San Diego from various sources.

3. That the City Auditor/Comptroller is hereby authorized:

a. To establish the necessary accounts; and

b. To appropriate and to allot all monies available to each project fund up to the amount of revenues available in each project fund.

4. That the City Auditor/Comptroller is hereby authorized to carry forward any unexpected balance remaining in each budgetary account at the end of each fiscal year into the next fiscal year as continuing appropriation, subject to amendment by the Agency.

5. That the President of CCDC, or designee, is hereby authorized to expend funds as appropriate for the Columbia Sub-Area Redevelopment Project.

6. That the President of CCDC, or designee, is hereby authorized to request the City Auditor and Comptroller to make budgetary transfers between the line items and object accounts within each project fund.

7. That the Agency authorizes the City Auditor/Comptroller, upon the request of CCDC, to transfer or loan funds between sub-projects within a project, provided that such transfers or loans do not increase or decrease the total project budgets or result in a use of such funds which would be inconsistent with the permitted uses of such funds.

8. That in the event the Agency desires to issue bonds, notes, or other instruments of indebtedness of the Agency to carry out redevelopment projects, then any indebtedness of the Agency to the City of San Diego, including any interest accrued thereon, shall be deemed not to be a first pledge of tax increment allocations received by the Agency pursuant to the California Health and Safety Code section 33670; and any indebtedness of the Agency to the City of San Diego, including any interest act to any pledge of tax increments to bondholders or

the holders of other such instruments of indebtedness.
