Committee member Cate thanked the San Diego Police Chief and the Northern Division for their attendance at a community coffee to address issues within Council District Six.

Chair Emerald commented on giving to local service providers that provide services to the homeless and violence on the homeless. She mentioned that the county of San Diego and the San Diego Housing Commission are here to discuss housing services for the homeless.

Chair Emerald thanked the Dallas Police Department and Southwest Airlines for providing support to the family of Dallas Officer Patricio E. Zamarripa's. She commented that a team of 911 dispatchers will be going to Dallas to cover that dispatch during the Dallas Police Department funerals. She encouraged the community to thank a police officer today. Chair Emerald thanked her council colleagues for their support of the proposed firehouse bond.
