4. The appeal does not present a city-wide issue on which guidance of the Committee on Public Safety and Neighborhood Services is required and the matter is not of city-wide significance; and
5. The Hearing Officer's decision is not in conflict with the adopted Council Policy or the Municipal Code.

ACTION: Motion by Councilmember Gloria, second by Councilmember Emerald, to direct the City Attorney to develop an ordinance for the regulation of medical marijuana cooperatives using the recommendations of the Medical Marijuana Task Force with two changes to the recommendations: 1) All cooperatives must be statutory entities as per the Attorney General's Guidelines; and 2) that labels on medications must include the patient's name, name of the cooperative, address, and if an edible product, the source of that food production.

And this ordinance be forwarded to the full City Council, in conjunction with the Land Use and Housing Committee's ordinance, for consideration.
