ALTERNATIVE APPROACHES TO RETIREMENT PLANS

ACTION: Motion by Councilmember Young, second by Councilmember Frye, to receive the report and state the committee's intent to continue the issue of retirement alternatives to the Rules Committee. To facilitate future discussions, the committee directed the Independent Budget Analyst to prepare the following materials and return for additional discussion at the Rules Committee: 1) a draft policy statement intended to guide plan design decisions, consistent with best practices as identified by the Government Finance Officers Association; 2) a detailed analysis of the CalPERS option including specifics about costs; and 3) examples of the impact of various retirement/pension options on employees including issues of employee retention and attraction.
