Additionally, Councilmember Cate also respectfully requested that Ethics Commission develop a list of any other recommended changes for Council consideration.

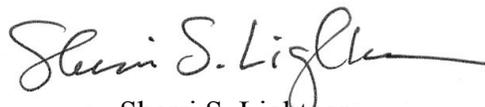
