Attached to this report is a copy of a ruling by Administrative Law Judges Lynn Carew and Brian Cragg of the CPUC regarding the above-captioned matter.

Also attached, in case you missed it in the San Diego Union, is an article by Charles Ross relating to the matter.

Mr. Ross' report is accurate with respect to the scope of the order. His surmise that the decision by the Administrative Law Judges may not be rendered until 1991 as a result of the reopening of the case may or may not be correct.

Be that as it may, we believe the ruling is to some degree the result of briefs filed by the City and the state attorney general, and are gratified to see that Judges Carew and Cragg saw the need for the additional evidence.

We believe that the Industrial Development Bond issue is a substantial concern. To the best of our knowledge, the applicants have been unable to persuade the Internal Revenue Service that defeasance is an appropriate alternative and we continue to believe that the Internal Revenue Service will not agree to allow that alternative.

It has been suggested that the applicants might attempt to remedy their dilemma with an amendment to the Federal Tax Law and we are closely monitoring that possibility.
