NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

LOCATION: The project site is located at 5571 Kearny Villa Road, San Diego, CA 92123.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The applicant is requesting a Right of Entry Permit (ROE) to permit boring at one test location to allow for the removal of a temporary monopole and installation of a permanent 50' monopine tree wireless communication facility (WCF). The project site on which the testing will occur is located at 5571 Kearny Villa Road in the Kearny Mesa Community Planning area. The project site is subject to the IL-2-1 zone.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The project, as described above, meets the criteria set forth in CEQA Section 15304 which addresses the minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water and/or vegetation which do not involve the removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. Additionally, none of the exceptions described in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 apply.
