PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project includes a Master Use and Occupancy Permit (MUOP) to allow for the installation of acoustic sensors on light poles in the public right of way and on various public structures located within the boundaries of the Encanto and Skyline-Paradise Hills Community Plan Areas. The acoustic sensors are paired with audio analysis software that identifies the unique signature of gunshots and other loud explosive sounds in real time. Installation of the devices is designed to be as least intrusive as possible; mounting hardware is unique to the structure on which it is being mounted.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The project, as described in the Project Description section of this notice, meets the criteria set forth in CEQA Section 15301(f) which allows for the addition of safety or health protection devices in conjunction with existing structures, facilities, or mechanical equipment, including navigational devices that would involve negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the determination. The project, as detailed in the Project Description section of this notice, would result in a negligible expansion of use. Additionally, none of the exceptions described in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 apply.
