NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NO: B-00718.02.06
PROJECT NAME: Trojan Avenue Phase II 54th to 56th Underground Utility District
COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Mid-City Eastern Area
COUNCIL DISTRICT: 9
LOCATION: Within the public right-of-way on Trojan Avenue from 54th Street to 56th Street

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project will install six street lights within the public right-of-way. The work will include but not be limited to trenching and installing conduit, street light poles, mast arms, light fixtures conductors, fuses, and fuse cartridges. The trench excavation will be 18 inches, and the light pole excavation depth will be 5 feet.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines Sections 15303 (New Construction), and Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review and determined the project meets the categorical exemption criteria set forth in the CEQA State Guidelines Section 15303, which allows for construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures (i.e. street lights); and Section 15304, which allows minor public alterations in the condition of land which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees, including minor trenching and backfilling where the surface is restored (i.e. trenching for conduit and installation of street light foundations and poles); and when the project does not trigger any of the exceptions to categorical exemptions found in State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15304.2. This project would not impact sensitive resources.
