NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: U&O Permit for County of San Diego Air Wing at El Capitan Reservoir

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Unincorporated communities of Alpine and Descanso, County of San Diego

LOCATION: 1,700 acres of City-owned property at El Capitan Reservoir, County of San Diego.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Authorize the City of San Diego to issue a Use & Occupancy Permit to the County of San Diego Air Wing at El Capitan Reservoir to perform water rescue training operations. The permit will be valid for up to five years and will require all activities to comply with the USFS Operational Guidelines.
