PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: CCTV Sewer Main Inspections- 2016/2017

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Citywide

COUNCIL DISTRICTS: All (1-9), City of San Diego

LOCATION: This project will access and inspect multiple manholes and sewer lines located throughout the City of San Diego in numerous Community Planning Areas. All inspections will occur to infrastructure located within the paved road right of way outside of the MHPA.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This project will inspect 1352 sewer line segments totaling approximately 61 miles in length throughout the City of San Diego. Inspections will occur by accessing the sewer lines through existing manholes, and inserting a camera connected to an inspection vehicle into the sewer line. The sewer mains to be inspected are located within the paved road right of way. No vegetation trimming or soil disturbance will occur as a result of this project.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

This project involves the inspections of existing sewer infrastructure. No vegetation removal or soil disturbance will occur as a result of this project, and therefore will not result in significant impacts to sensitive biological or archaeological resources. Furthermore, the project meets criteria set forth in CEQA Section 15301 which allows for maintenance of existing facilities, infrastructure, and appurtenances; and where the exception listed in Section 15300.2 would not apply.
