NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: Replacement of the Vulcan II Work Barge

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of replacing the Vulcan II Work Barge for Mission Bay Park. Mission Bay Park is a saltwater bay located south of the Pacific Beach community of San Diego, California. The City currently owns and operates a work barge designed and equipped to provide the care and maintenance of 180 navigational buoys and 170 permanent moorings. The Vulcan II has reached the end of its serviceable life and no longer fulfills the needs of the City's Park and Recreation Department. A replacement work barge is needed to ensure public safety in and around Mission Bay Park's coastline. Like the existing work barge the replacement work barge would be able to maneuver in shallow waters and close quarters, and provide towing and salvage of other vessels of various sizes and shapes.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically Exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15302 (Replacement or Reconstruction) and Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego
Mayor-Appointed Designee.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review and determined the project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15302, Replacement or Reconstruction as the project consists of construction of a replacement work barge which is of similar size and construction as the existing work barge. Subsequent operations of the replacement barge would be exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 Existing Facilities as the work barge operations are to provide the care and maintenance of 180 navigational buoys and 170 permanent moorings; and the project does not trigger any of the exceptions to the exemptions listed in CEQA Guidelines §15300.2.
