NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

PROJECT NAME: As-Needed Design Services Agreement – Scripps Ranch Storm Drain Replacement Project
COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Scripps Miramar Ranch
COUNCIL DISTRICT: 5

LOCATION: The project is located at Birch Bluff Avenue, Rue Chantemar, Rue Cheaumont and crosses between various residential properties to extend into the canyon areas.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Issue an As-Needed design services agreement with Rick Engineering Company for the purposes of providing civil design services for Scripps Ranch Storm Drain Replacement Project. Services include the preparation of construction documents for the replacement and/or realignment of the existing corrugated metal pipe (CMP) storm drain pipes with reinforced concrete pipe (RCP). Additional services include utility research; alignment evaluations; field surveys; preparation of technical reports, specifications, maps and legal descriptions, drawings; geotechnical investigation/evaluation; project management and coordination; public outreach; and other associated services.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines Section 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Public Works Department

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review, which determined the action meets the statutory exemption criteria set forth in CEQA State Guidelines Section 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies) in order to approve the design contract only, which includes ground-disturbing activities for geotechnical investigation/evaluation.
