NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PROJECT NAME: As-Needed Design Services Agreement – Sunset Cliffs Natural Park Hillside Drainage Improvements
COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: Peninsula

LOCATION: The project is generally located south of Ladera Street and west of Lomaland Drive.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Issue an As-Needed design services agreement with Rick Engineering Company for the purposes of providing grading and drainage design services for Sunset Cliffs Natural Park. Services include the preparation of construction documents for the drainage system for the park, and to also include two parking lots, as identified by the Sunset Cliffs Natural Park Master Plan. Additional services include preliminary drainage and BMP analysis, alignment evaluations; field surveys; preparation of technical reports, specifications, maps and legal descriptions, drawings; geotechnical investigation/evaluation; project management and coordination; public outreach; and other associated services.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines Section 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Public Works Department

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review, which determined the action meets the statutory exemption criteria set forth in CEQA State Guidelines Section 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies) in order to approve the design contract only, which includes ground-disturbing activities for geotechnical investigation/evaluation.
