PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: Temporary Exhibit of Artwork Agreement

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: City Heights

LOCATION: Street light poles on University and Fairmount Avenues within the City Heights maintenance assessment district boundaries.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Authorize the Mayor or his designee to sign a Temporary Exhibit of Artwork Agreement allowing City Heights Business Association (Exhibitor) to install a temporary exhibit of artwork on street light poles from October 24, 2016 through October 27, 2017.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: This activity has been determined to be exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effect on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action, and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.
