NOTICE OF APPLICATION

DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT

As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, you should know that an application has been filed with the City of San Diego (City) for a Site Development Permit (SDP) for an Eruv, a symbolic boundary established in accordance with Jewish law that allows observant Jews to carry certain items outdoors within the designated area during the Sabbath (Shabbat), activities that would otherwise be restricted. This is an effort by multiple synagogues working together to create a boundary line designed to incorporate as many places of worship or faith communities as possible. The Eruv will consist of natural features and erected in other areas by attaching a 200-pound monofilament line that is strung between existing light poles, utility poles, fencing and traffic signals within the City's public right-of-way. The installation of approximately 10,000 linear feet of monofilament line requires an SDP for any encroachment or object which is erected, placed, constructed, established or maintained in the public right-of-way when the applicant is not the record owner of the property. There are several approved Eruv lines already operating within the City of San Diego including one south of Interstate 8 (I-8) within the College Area.

The Eruv route is located within the City and State public right-of-way beginning at I-8, extending north along Fairmount Avenue, then continuing east along Friars Road and Mission Gorge to the east and north, connecting to State Route 52 (SR-52) to the east then continuing south along SR-125, then west along the I-8 until reconnecting with Fairmount Avenue. The Eruv is located in the various base zones within the Navajo, East Elliott, and College Area Community Plan areas. A separate permit application with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be concurrently submitted for the Eruv route located within the State public right-of-way.
