PLEASE ACCEPT THIS AS A NOTICE TO INFORM YOU, as a property owner, tenant or interested citizen, that the Council of The City of San Diego, California will conduct a public hearing, as part of a scheduled City Council meeting, on the following project:

An application for a Site Development Permit and Easement Vacation to remove a Building Restricted and Slope Easement to allow for grading and improvements for a future single-dwelling residential unit lot on a 10.24-acre, undeveloped Lot 31 within Rancho Del Sol Unit 1 Map No. 12477, located at 13165 Caminito Mendiola within the RX-1-2, AR-1-1 zones and Coastal Overlay (Deferred Certification) zone in the Pacific Highlands Ranch Community Plan. The site is currently governed by City of San Diego Planned Residential Development Permit 86-0229 and California Coastal Commission Permit 6-86-699. This development is within the Coastal Overlay zone and the application was filed on September 19, 2016.

A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) Project No. 506590/SCH No. 2022120055 and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) has been prepared for the project in accordance with the State of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines. The MND determined that the proposed project could have a significant environmental effect related to Biological Resources, Cultural Resources (Archaeology) and Tribal Cultural Resources and specific mitigation is identified in the MND which avoids or mitigates the potentially significant environmental effects. The implementation of the MMRP reduced all impacts to below a level of significance.

The final decision by the City of San Diego is not appealable to the California Coastal Commission. If you want to receive a Notice of Final Action, you must submit a written request to the City Project Manager listed above.

## The decision of the City Council is final.
