**PLEASE ACCEPT THIS AS A NOTICE TO INFORM YOU, as a property owner, tenant or interested citizen, that the Council of The City of San Diego, California will conduct a public hearing, previously noticed for June 16, 2026 but rescheduled for July 13, 2026, as part of a scheduled City Council meeting, on the following project:**

This action seeks City Council approval of an ordinance to repeal Measure C approved in the Municipal Election held on November 8, 2022. Measure C amended the People's Ordinance O-10960 and San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) to exclude the Midway-Pacific Highway Community Plan Area from the 30-foot height limit on buildings in the Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone. The proposed ordinance would amend SDMC Section 132.0505 to remove the exclusion for the Midway-Pacific Highway Community Plan Area from the 30-foot height limit on buildings in the Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone.

This action is necessary to implement a writ of mandate in Case No. 37-2022-00035094-CU-TT-CTL issued by the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, which ordered the City of San Diego to repeal the San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) Section 132.0505 amendments approved by Measure C.

The Environmental Analysis Section of the City Planning Department has reviewed the proposed SDMC amendment (project) and has determined that the proposed action to adopt an ordinance amending Section 132.0505 of the SDMC to repeal Measure C is not subject to CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15060(c)(1) and (2) as the activity does not involve the exercise of discretionary powers by a public agency, and it will also not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

The ordinance to repeal Measure C applies to property located in the Coastal Zone; therefore, the City Council's decision requires amending the City's Local Coastal Program. The final decision on the portions of the action that are the City's Local Coastal Program will be with the California Coastal Commission. The City of San Diego will submit the ordinance to repeal Measure C to the California Coastal Commission for certification following City Council and Airport Land Use Commission action. The ordinance to repeal Measure C will not be effective in the coastal zone until the Coastal Commission unconditionally certifies the Local Coastal Program Amendment.

If you wish to be noticed of the Coastal Commission hearing on this action, you must submit a request in writing to the City of San Diego City Planning Department, Attention: Corey Funk, Senior Planner, 202 C Street, M.S. 413, San Diego, CA 92101 or cfunk@sandiego.gov before the close of the City Council public hearing. If you wish to challenge the City's action on the above proceedings in court, you may be limited to addressing only those issues you or someone else have raised at the public hearing described in this notice or written in correspondence to the City at or before the public hearing.

**The decision of the City Council is final.**
