As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to **recommend** approval, conditional approval, or denial to the City Council of an application for a Coastal Development Permit, Site Development Permit, and Public Right-of-Way Vacation to vacate a 20-foot-wide unnamed alley totaling 6,518 square feet located at 10801 Sorrento Valley Road. The 0.15-acre site is in the IL-3-1 Zone, Coastal Overlay Zone (Non-Appealable), Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (MCAS Miramar), Airport Influence Areas (MCAS Miramar, Review Area 1), Parking Impact Overlay Zone (Coastal Impact), Parking Standards Transit Priority Area, and Transit Priority Area within the Torrey Pines Community Plan area.

The decision to approve, conditionally approve, modify or deny the vacation of a 20-foot-wide unnamed alley totaling 6,518 square feet will be made by the City Council at a future public hearing. You will also receive a notice of the City Council public hearing.

This project was determined to be statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15061(b)(3) (Common Sense). The environmental exemption determination for this project was made on January 11, 2024.

This development is within the Coastal Overlay zone and the application was filed on February 26, 2020.

The final decision by the City of San Diego is not appealable to the California Coastal Commission. If you want to receive a Notice of Final Action, you must submit a written request to the Development Project Manager listed above.
