As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, you should know that a public hearing will be held by the Planning Commission to consider an application for a Tentative Map for the conversion of 21 apartment units within three existing buildings into condominium units located at 2916 through 2996 Worden Street. The 1.2-acre project site is in the RM-3-7 Zone and the Transit Priority Area Overlay Zone within the Peninsula Community Plan area. The proposed project site is not within the Coastal Overlay Zone.

Should the condominium conversion project be approved, tenants may be required to vacate the premises. No units may be sold in this building unless the conversion is approved by the city and until after a public report is issued by the Department of Real Estate. Each tenant has the exclusive right to contract for the purchase of his or her respective unit upon the same terms and conditions that such unit will be initially offered to the general public or terms more favorable to the tenant. The right shall run for a period of not less than 90 days from the date of issuance of the subdivision public report pursuant to Section 11018.2 of the Business and Professions Code, unless the tenant gives prior written notice of his or her intention not to exercise the right.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15332 (In-Fill Development Projects) of the California Environmental Quality Act on January 17, 2024, and the opportunity to appeal that determination ended January 31, 2024.

#### **APPEALS:**

The decision of the Planning Commission is final unless appealed to the City Council. In order to appeal the decision of the Planning Commission, you must register as a speaker at the public hearing concerning the application or have expressed interest in webform or in writing to the Planning Commission, (<a href="https://www.sandiego.gov/planning-commission">https://www.sandiego.gov/planning-commission</a>), before the close of the public hearing. Appeal procedures are described in <a href="https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505">https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505</a>). The appeal must be made no later than ten (10) business days after the date of the Planning Commission's decision. If you wish to challenge the City's action on the above proceedings in court, you may be limited to addressing only those issues you or someone else have raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or written in correspondence to the City at or before the public hearing. The decision of the City Council is final. Appeals to the City Clerk may be filed by e-mail or in person as follows:

The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.
