As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to **recommend** approval, conditional approval, or denial to the City Council of an application for an amendment to the Otay Mesa-Nestor Community Plan, Rezone, Site Development Permit, Neighborhood Development Permit, Vesting Tentative Map, and Multi-Habitat Planning Area Boundary Line Adjustment to subdivide a 5.92-acre site for the development of 198 multi-family dwelling units (including the provision of eight 8 affordable homes). The project site is located at 555 Hollister Street in the RM-1-1 (Residential – Multiple Unit), RS-1-7 (Residential – Single Unit), and AR-1-2 (Agricultural-Residential) zones, Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zones (NAS North Island, Imperial Beach NOLF, and Brown Field), and the Transit Priority Area of the Otay Mesa-Nestor Community Plan.

The decision to approve, conditionally approve, modify or deny the Palm & Hollister Apartments project will be made by the City Council at a future public hearing. You will also receive a notice of the City Council public hearing.

The certification of the Environmental Impact Report may be appealed to the City Council. All such appeals must be filed by 5:00 PM within ten (10) business days from the date of the Development Services Department certification/adoption of the environmental document. Appeal procedures are described in <a href="Information Bulletin 505">Information Bulletin 505</a> (<a href="https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505">Information-bulletins/505</a>) and as follows:

Bring the fully completed appeal application DS-3031 (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building—Public Information Counter (Open 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday excluding City-approved holidays),1st Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00 PM on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.
