As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, you should know that a public hearing will be held by the Planning Commission to consider an application for a Site Development Permit for the construction of a one-mile-long pedestrian, bicycle, and equestrian trail extension of the Coast to Crest (CTC) Trail, composed of decomposed granite, a 150-foot-long trail bridge spanning the San Dieguito River, site improvements including native landscaping, habitat restoration and site improvements (trail fencing and signage), in the AR-1-1 (Agricultural - Residential), AR-1-2 (Agricultural - Residential) and predominantly within the OF-1-1(Open Space - Floodplain) zones of the Fairbanks Ranch Country Club Community Plan Area. The 1.8-acre site is located east of Interstate 5, and approximately two miles east of El Camino Real and lies between Via De La Valle to the west, and San Dieguito Road to the east at 14555 El Camino Real.

This project is within the scope of the San Dieguito River Park Osuna Segment of the Coast to Crest Trail Mitigated Negative Declaration (<u>SCH No. 2023050120</u>), adopted on July 21, 2023, by the San Dieguito River Park Joint Powers Authority. This MND adequately describes the activity for the purposes of CEQA.

APPEALS:

The decision of the Planning Commission is final unless appealed to the San Diego City Council. In order to appeal the decision of the Planning Commission, you must register as a speaker at the public hearing concerning the application or have expressed interest in web form or in writing to the Planning Commission (https://www.sandiego.gov/planning-commission) before the close of the public hearing. Appeal procedures are described in Information Bulletin 505 (https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505). The appeal must be made no later than ten (10) business days after the date of the Planning Commission's decision. If you wish to challenge the City's action on the above proceedings in court, you may be limited to addressing only those issues you or someone else have raised at the public hearing described in this notice or written in correspondence to the City at or before the public hearing. The decision of the City Council is final. Appeals to the City Clerk may be filed by e-mail or in person as follows:

- 2) Appeals filed in person: Bring the fully completed appeal application <u>DS-3031</u> (https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/development-services/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031.pdf) (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building—Public Information Counter, 1st Floor Lobby, (Open 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday excluding Cityapproved holidays) located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00 PM on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.
